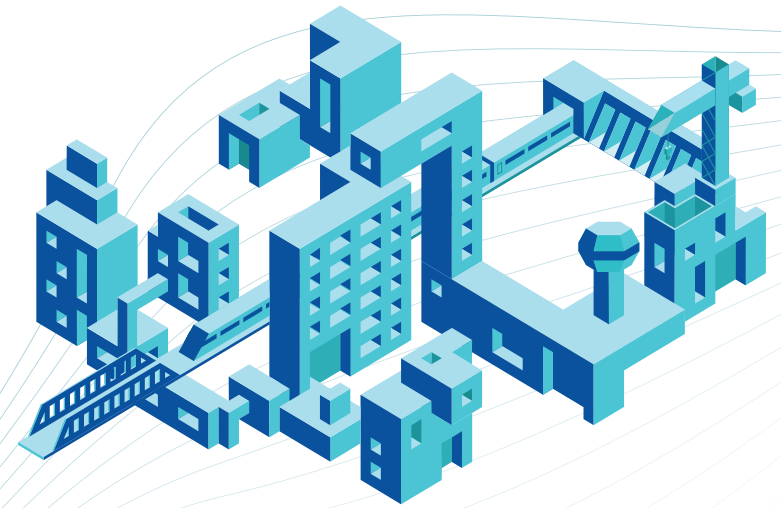

### Resiliency through international collaboration

From October 18<sup>th</sup> to October 21<sup>st</sup>, the international community of experts in BIM and digital transformation in the built asset industry will meet at the buildingSMART International Summit in Montreal, Quebec, Canada to address how to **drive digital transformation to facilitate resilience in the built asset industry through international collaboration**. Hosted by buildingSMART International, buildingSMART Canada & Groupe BIM du Quebec, and held for the first time since 2014 in North America, this international summit will hold several conferences, demonstrations, and exhibitions.

This urgency to act requires bold steps be taken to ensure the resiliency and sustainability of the built asset industry. Digital transformation can provide significant opportunities to address this crisis and allay these pressures.
